### **Apprentice Application Process**

ITA registered Apprentices may be eligible for temporary financial supports while they attend ITA–approved training for their apprenticeship.

There are 2 <u>SEPARATE</u> but connected applications that <u>MUST</u> be completed.

BE PREPARED – you will need your:

- ✓ your ITA number
- ✓ Social Insurance Number
- ✓ Void cheque or banking information
- ✓ Name of Course, Training Institution & the start and end dates of your class.

#### **STEP 1: Complete a WorkBC Apprentice Supports Application Online**

Financial supports include basic expenses for living away from home, dependent care, daily commuting, living and disability supports.

<u>IMPORTANT:</u> You may start the application process 4 weeks PRIOR to your school start date. You must apply by the first day of your course – if you are late, please contact WorkBC to have your eligibility assessed.

Your 16-Digit Reference code will be issued upon completion of this application and can be obtained by logging in to your BCeid account. \*\*\*This may take up to 2 business days.

#### STEP 2: Apply for Service Canada Employment Insurance

IMPORTANT: You MUST obtain your 16-Digit Reference Code which is aligned to your current class. Additional classes require re-application where you will be issued a new 16 Digit Reference Code.

- You cannot apply for EI more than 7 days before the start date of your apprentice training
- Submit your ROE as soon as possible
- Have you 16-Digit Reference Code ready
